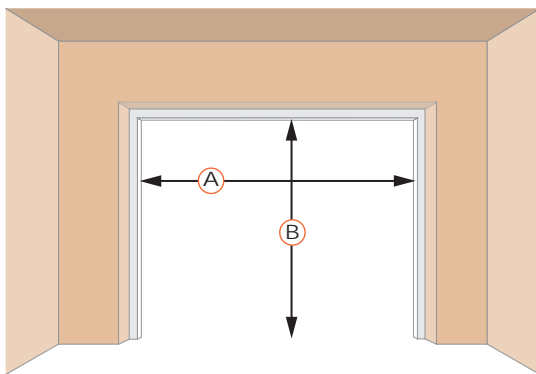




Measure sheet 1 - fitting to an existing timber frame

Use this sheet if you are fitting your new door to an existing timber frame. If you are fitting a new steel or timber frame, you should select the measure sheet for that situation instead. You can download the correct measure sheet from the website www.mynewdoor.co.uk

If you plan to use the existing timber frame, ensure that it is sound, square and secure and that the timber is the recommended size of 75mm x 75mm (3" x 3"). Always measure from more than one point as brickwork or the timber frame may not be consistent.
