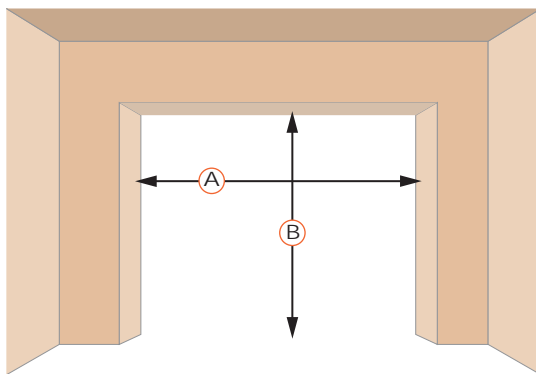




Measure sheet 4 - fitting a new timber frame within the brickwork opening

Use this sheet if you are fitting your new door using a new timber frame within the brickwork opening. If you are fitting to an existing timber frame, fitting a new timber frame behind the brickwork or fitting a new steel frame, you should select the measure sheet for that situation instead. You can download the correct measure sheet from the website www.mynewdoor.co.uk

First remove any existing timber frame and make good any damage to the brickwork. Always measure from more than one point as brickwork may not be consistent.



A Measure the width of the opening from brickwork to brickwork:

B Measure the height of the opening from floor to brickwork:

Now use the chart below to find the correct door size to fit your opening:
